Minimum Requirements:

Qualified applicants should have coursework and experience in the fields of fisheries management, aquatic biology, or related environmental science. All internships offered are outdoor, field-based, and will require physical labor. Some overnight stays may be required. Interns will work an average of 45 hours per week.
