I received your name through my recruiting and networking with Iowa State, I have a project that might be interesting to your students and workers of the Insect Zoo, and I was hoping you might be willing to share it?

Conservation Corps of Minnesota and Iowa is an AmeriCorps program that focuses on natural resource and environmental focused project. Starting in May and running through December we will have a Monarch Study Crew working across Iowa. The crew member position involves habitat study projects including but are not limited to pollinator counts, milkweed stem counts, and maintaining and organization field data. Project sites vary throughout Iowa, including urban settings and wilderness. The project will require camping for several days at a time (We provide transportation and camping equipment). The project is a great entry-level opportunity. The monthly living stipend is \$1450 and the education award at the competition of term is \$3,047 that can be applied to student loans or future education costs.
