

POSTDOC: Spatial mechanisms of (plant) diversity maintenance

An exciting postdoc opportunity is available at The University of Queensland, Australia.

Dr John Dwyer and Prof. Margie Mayfield are looking for a postdoctoral researcher with strong field, quantitative and writing skills to test ecological theory on spatial mechanisms of species coexistence. The position will involve fieldwork in our favourite annual plant study system in Western Australia, the very diverse and picturesque York gum woodlands.

This position is for a two-year, full time postdoctoral researcher based at The University of Queensland in Brisbane Australia. Applicants must have a PhD in ecology or a related/relevant field of research. We are particularly interested in candidates with a strong background in field ecology who also have excellent analytical and statistical skills. Key elements of this position include the ability to conduct exciting independent community ecology research, the ability to take research from development stages to publication and the willingness and ability to mentor students from undergraduate to graduate levels. The successful candidate is expected to produce multiple publications in international peer-reviewed journals, and to present research at domestic and international conferences.
