The Indiana Department of Natural Resources has openings for seasonal professional level forester technician positions at State Forest properties.

Forest Technician Intern:

These positions work in the Division of Forestry under the supervision of a state forest property manager on various state forests. These forests are located in Indiana, in the heart of the Central Hardwoods Region. The position manages land, facilities, people, timber, and other natural resources on state forest holdings. Duties may include forest inventory, development of management plans, boundary line management, marking timber harvests, timber sale administration, forest stand improvement, invasive species management, wildlife management, road and access management, tree planting, recreation and facilities management, and public information/education. The emphasis may be on invasive species management and inventory.

Required Experience: These positions require someone working toward a Bachelor of Science in Forestry, or closely associated field from an accredited college/university. Prefer tree or plant identification training.
